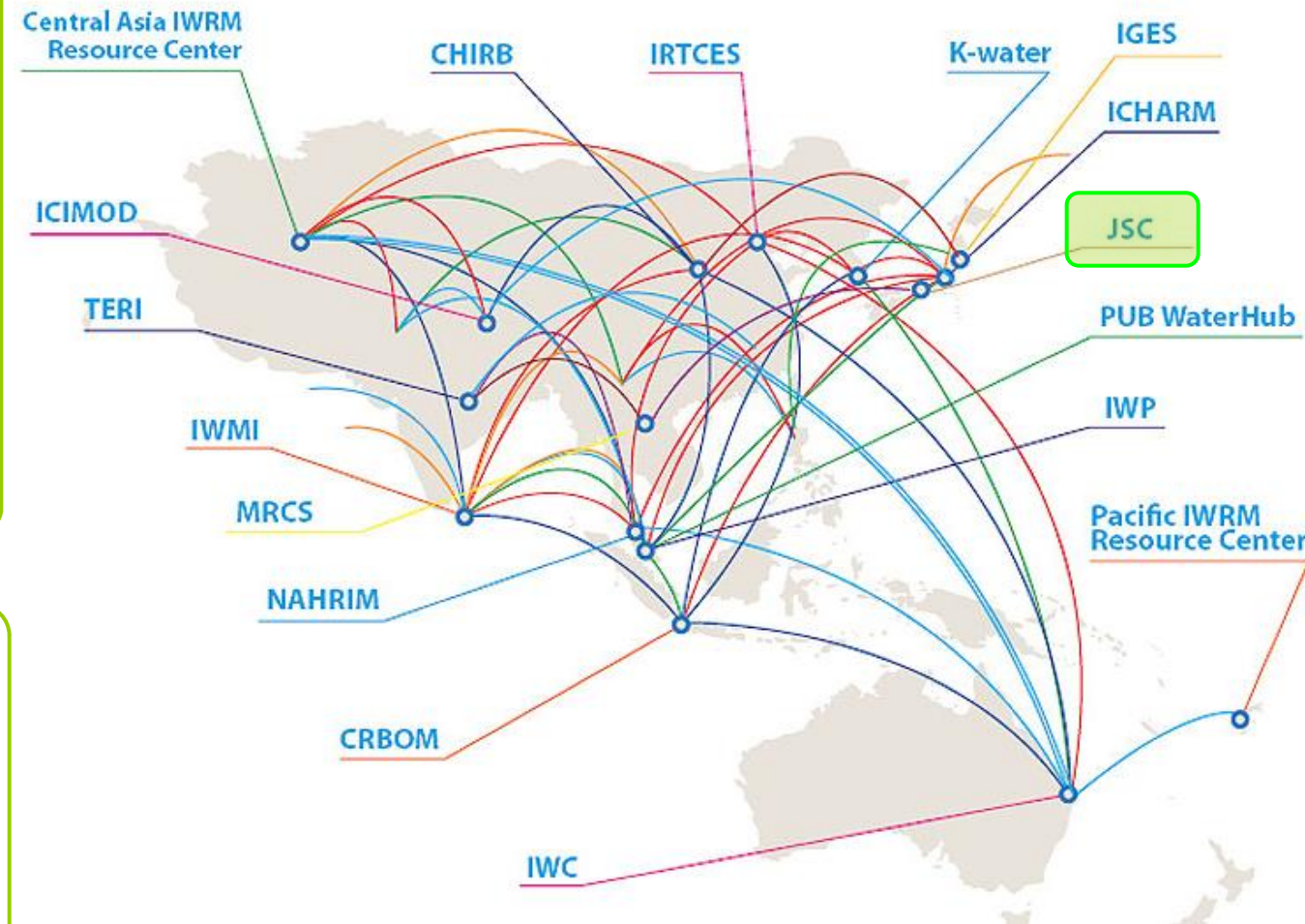

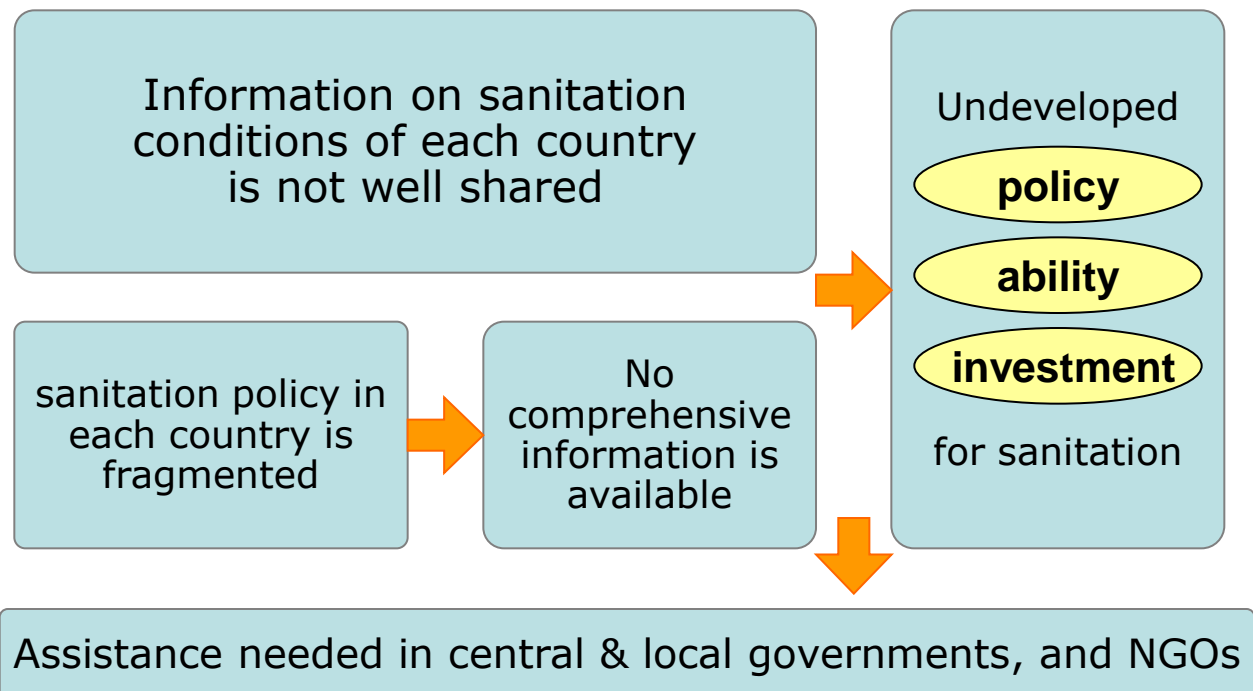

KnowledgeHubs of the Asia-Pacific Water Forum (APWF)

- *KnowledgeHubs* is the APWF's network of regional water knowledge hubs.
- Each Hub has a specific priority water topic and works to improve water security, promote knowledge exchange and solutions to solve water issues in the Asia-Pacific region.
- Currently, there are 17 Hubs covering different water priority topics. Besides JSC in Japan, the two following organizations are included in the KnowledgeHubs network:
 - Global Center of Excellence for Water Hazard and Risk Management (ICHARM)
 - Institute for Global Environmental Strategies (IGES)
- JSC has been endorsed as a new KnowledgeHub along with IGES, at the APWF Governing Council organized in Singapore in June 2009.

Sanitation Issues in the Asia-Pacific Region



JSC: KnowledgeHub for Sanitation

Objectives

- Establish or improve policy and political determination to develop sanitation
- Increase technical/managerial knowledge and expert staff
- Develop capacity-building for wastewater/sludge management
- Promote the diffusion of:
 - basic sanitation (toilets) with proper wastewater/sludge management systems
 - on-site sanitation (including johkasou and night soil/sludge collection & treatment)
 - off-site sanitation (sewerage)

Tasks

- Gather and diffuse information
- Consolidate, share and spread knowledge through the KnowledgeHubs network and collaboration with international organizations (non-Hub organizations)
- Support, advise clients and partners (central & local governments, NGOs, etc.)

Activities

- Networking:
 - identify the sanitation-related institutions in each country
 - manage information networks
- Comprehensive country surveys:
 - understand sanitation conditions
 - conduct sanitation mapping and advise for sanitation system improvement
- Create and manage a database for sanitation in the Asia-Pacific region
- Collaborate with international donor agencies (ADB, JICA, etc.) and other international organizations (UNICEF, World Toilet Organization, etc.)
